10 or 12 days | Rio de Janeiro | Iguazú | Buenos Aires | Extension to Argentina

Indulge in South American culture at its finest by exploring Brazil and Argentina. Begin with a stroll down Rio's beach, then see the iconic Christ the Redeemer statue overlooking the city. Don't miss spectacular Iguazú Falls, one of the great natural wonders of the world. Continue to Buenos Aires for a Fiesta Gaucha ranch visit with folk dancing and horseback riding.

What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to Brazil

Day 2: Rio de Janeiro

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Rio de Janeiro, which has evolved from a Portuguese outpost on the edge of the New World to one of the greatest cities in South America. While here, marvel at the elegant colonial and neo-classical architecture that endures amid its soaring skyscrapers. Enter November 15 Square, named for the day when Marechal Deodoro de Fonseca, the first president, proclaimed the Republic of Brazil. Once the hub of Rio de Janeiro's social and political life, the square is host to one of the city's oldest craft markets. Here you'll see the Pyramid Fountain, built in 1743, and the Paço Imperial, which used to serve as the royal palace and seat of government.
- Take a guided tour of Colonial Rio: colonial architecture; Catedral Metropolitana; Paço Imperial.

Day 3: Corcovado | Rio de Janeiro

- Visit Corcovado.
- Enjoy a BBQ lunch and beach tour.
- Enjoy a free evening.

Day 4: Rio de Janeiro

- Enjoy a cruise on Guanabara Bay with views of Sugar Loaf.
- Visit a samba school and participate in a samba dance lesson.

Day 5: Rio de Janeiro | Iguazú

- Fly to Iguazú, where you'll visit the breathtaking Iguazú Falls. With 275 falls cascading over a precipice nearly two miles wide and 269 feet high, the Iguazú Falls are no comparison to Niagara Falls. While here you'll see the falls from both the Brazilian and the Argentinean sides on separate days. Iguazú National Park is home to more than 2,000 plant varieties and nearly 400 bird species, including toucans, parakeets, and hummingbirds. Travel by jeep into the park and take in the beauty of subtropical plants and trees. Then hike into the forest, keeping your eyes peeled for exotic wildlife such as the capuchin monkey, the coatimundi, and the tapir.

Day 6: Iguazú

- See the Iguazú Falls from the Brazilian side.
- Participate in a boat ride.

Day 7: Iguazú Falls | Buenos Aires

- See the Iguazú Falls from the Argentinian side.
- Fly to Buenos Aires and discover the city where tango was born. During your visit you'll view the National Congress and head to Plaza de Mayo, home to Casa Rosada (the government house), the Metropolitan Cathedral, and the Cabildo (the first city hall built during Spanish rule). Continue on to San Telmo, the city's oldest barrio where tango performances abound. Then stop in the colorful neighborhood of La Boca, an area once inhabited by immigrants that has become a hub for the city's artists. You can admire the Colón Theatre, one of the world's best-known opera houses. After seeing Palermo, the city's largest neighborhood, your tour will conclude in the glamorous Recoleta area, where you can visit the grave of Eva Perón (Evita).

Day 8: Buenos Aires

- Take a guided tour of Buenos Aires: Plaza de Mayo; San Telmo; La Boca; Colon Theatre; Palermo; Recoleta.
- Enjoy a free evening or [take a tango lesson](#).

Day 9: Buenos Aires | Depart for home

- Participate in a Fiesta Gaucha excursion.
- Depart for home.

Day 10: Arrive home
